

## Changing the Security Settings on the new Windows XP SP-2 to run with MissionBase Replication Tools (synchronization):

Click the 

followed by the 

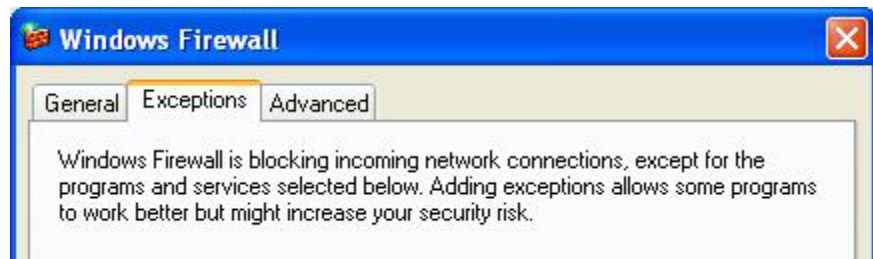
If you are in the “Category View” you will see a “Security Center” symbol in the lower right corner of the screen. If not, you will see it listed alphabetically as “Security Center” with the other program options.



In the Security Center, where it says “Manage Security Settings For:” click the “Windows Firewall” option.



Click on the “Exceptions” tab as shown...



Then, click to “Add Program...”  
Use the BROWSE button, and locate your **C:\MissionBase\Programs\Replication.exe**



Click to “Open” it,  
Then click “OK” to close the screen from which you clicked “Browse.”

Now you should find “Replication” in your list of Exceptions. Make sure it has a checkmark in the box next to it, indicating that it is to be allowed as an exception to blocked programs. Then the Windows Firewall will not block it from running in the future.

If you DO ever see a message pop-up when you attempt to run Replication Tools that states to UNBLOCK or continue to BLOCK this program.... select the UNBLOCK option. This should add it into your Exceptions programs if it was not previously added.
